

TODAY'S MARKET REVIEW

The stock market witnessed a nosedive in its benchmark index today amid the lowest investors' participation since July 10, 2016. The market started the day's session with profit booking sell pressure and continued till the end without any major sign of reversal. The investors opted for liquidating their position from almost all the sectors which indicates the investors' low confidence on the market. Recent liquidity crisis in the banking sector and turbulent capital market behavior basically downgraded the investor's buoyance. Total turnover decreased by 14% over the previous session. Top gainers and losers lists were dominated by small cap stocks whereas turnover list was dominated by large cap stocks. At the day's end, the DSEX, DSES and DS30 lost 54.6 points, 9.2 points and 17.6 points respectively to their previous day's level.

Almost all the sectors witnessed correction today. Among the major sectors based on market capitalization – financial institution (-1.5%), bank (-1.4%), engineering (-1.4%) and telecom (-0.8%) sectors witnessed price correction while only life insurance (0.5%) sector achieved price appreciation in the day's session. The investors' activity was mostly centered on engineering (16.0%), textile (14.2%) and pharmaceutical (13.5%) sectors while MONNOCERA (4.7%), GP (4.4%) and CVOPRL (3.6%) led the scrip wise turnover board today.

The port city bourse, CSE decreased by 124.77 points in its broad based index – CASPI.




DSE NEWS IN BRIEF
